TO ALL PLAYERS, PARENTS, GRANDPARENTS, FRIENDS AND RELATIVES

Thank you for being involved with the Landsdale Junior Football Club Inc during the 2009 season (and for many the last 10 years) and we look forward to your continued involvement in what will be a very exciting 2010.

The 2010 season will bring many changes and a fresh start for the club which has just completed its 10th year of operation, starting in 2000 as an Auskick centre with 47 participants growing to 470 participants in 2009.

We have a new President for 2010 in Gavin Oliphant and a mixture of new people and the return of some previous committee members who are enthusiastically looking forward to challenges ahead for the 2010 season.

Firstly you will notice that the club has changed its name to Kingsway Junior Football Club Inc which was approved by the members in attendance at the Club's 2009 AGM held last October.

The main reasons for the name change were;

- ❖ To be better identified as a locality or region encompassing the suburbs from which the majority of players come from including Landsdale, Darch, Madeley and Marangaroo. When the Club was first formed the suburb of Landsdale extended from Alexander Drive to Wanneroo Road, but has subsequently been split to include the suburbs of Darch and Madeley.
- ❖ To better align the Junior and Senior Football Clubs (Kingsway Football and Sporting Club) who have worked hard over a number of years to forge a pathway for our junior players to continue at the same club to play senior football. The Senior Club has also had some changes in recent years changing from Wanneroo (Sunday League) Football Club to Wanneroo Kingsway FC and subsequently to Kingsway FC. These changes have also seen the change of jumpers for the senior club to be the combined junior and old senior club jumper which is worn by the senior teams and some of the juniors open rules teams. This will also have some financial benefits with regards to sponsorship and fund raising.

Whilst the name will be same, it will still remain as two separate entities as the Junior and Senior Football Clubs.

As part of this change of name the club will be required to replace playing jumpers over the next couple of seasons. This season all open rules teams will play in the combined jumper that has been used by the 16/17's for the last 3 seasons and by the senior club for the last 2 seasons.

The second major change for 2010 is that as a result of the WAFC District Boundary Review, we have been rezoned to the Lions (Subiaco) District Football Development Council. This has been reported in the media just prior to Christmas and will mean some significant changes for our Club.

Games for modified rules (Year 4 to 12's) which were played on Saturday mornings in the East Perth District will now be played on Sundays along with all open rules games.

We understand that this may affect a number of players and families who for various reasons are unable to participate on Sundays. We will make every endeavour to accommodate all of our current players who wish to continue in 2010. For players who are unable to participate on Sundays we will be able to give you some guidance as to Saturday competitions available for you to continue playing in 2010.

The normal time slots (subject to ground availability) are on Sundays as follows

Year 4 (9's) and Year 5 (10's)	8.30am
11's and 12's	10.00am
13's and 14's	11.30am/1.00pm
15's, 16's and 17's	1.00pm / 3.00pm

The modified rules games will start earlier at 8.30am competing against teams from Carine, Karrinyup Saints, Kingsley, Sorrento Duncraig, Warwick Greenwood and a return to playing Balga and Central Cougars who moved from East Perth in 2008.

The open rules competition becomes a combined competition with the Claremont District with two divisions in each age group from 13's to 15's, a separate 16's age group competing against teams from clubs as follows Subiaco District - Carine, Karrinyup Saints, Kingsley, Sorrento Duncraig, Warwick Greenwood and Northern Cobras.

Claremont District – Claremont, Cottesloe, Dalkeith Nedlands, Marist, North Beach, Scarborough, Subiaco, Swanbourne, Wembley Downs and West Coast.

The 17's age group is a separate competition (not combined 16/17's) and has been a combined competition with teams from clubs from the Subiaco, Claremont and West Perth districts.

For this season Auskick sessions will continue to be held on Sundays. We understand that there will be a clash of times for families who have players in both Auskick and modified rules (especially year 4 and year 5) but this means that all football is on Sundays so that all our volunteers are only tied up for one day over the weekend. This also gives the opportunity for those parents that work on Saturdays to be able to participate.

The registration day for 2010 will be held on Sunday 21 February 2010 at Kingsway Football Club, Skeit Road Madeley from 10.00am to 2.00pm. We have changed to one venue this year to allow all committee and volunteers to be at one centre at the same time with more space to operate. We will not need to hire the Warradale Community Centre from City of Wanneroo and have potential clashes with other users (and parking hassles). We will also endeavour to have senior club players and officials in attendance on the day so that the juniors can interact and identify with the senior club players and may be some skill sessions. Galadent Dental will be in attendance for mouthguard fittings.

Registration day is Sunday 21 February 2010 from 10.00am to 2.00pm at Kingsway Football Club, Kingsway Sporting Complex, Skeit Road Madeley.

Auskick players registering will also need to register online. Go to the AFL Auskick website (www.aflauskick.com.au) and follow the steps. When completed please print out the AFL form and attach it to your club registration form on registration day.

Parents of players in Year 4 (previously 9's) to 17's, with the numbers in each age group rapidly increasing, we strongly recommend that you return the registration form as soon as possible to ensure that your child is placed in the same team as last season. Where there are excess numbers of players for a team preference will be given to those who have returned their forms early.
